### Art Show 2023

Overall we sold 28 paintings ranging in price from \$50 to \$1,100; this does not include the Table Sales which added to the overall result. 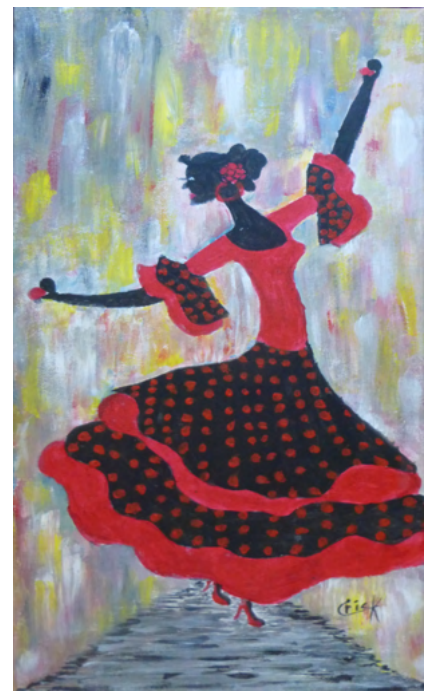

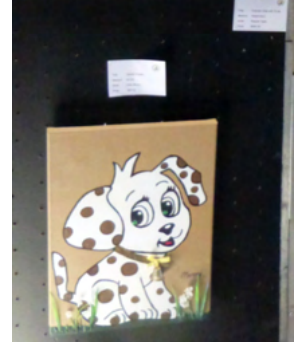

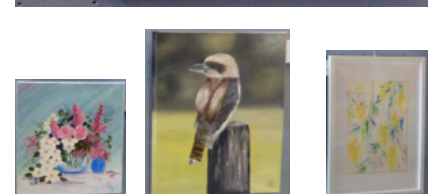
